Korean Community Center

(KCC) is a nonprofit, 501 (c)(3) charitable organization.

KCC's Mission is to promote healthy and independent living for all ages and to integrate the people with Korean heritage into the greater community through culture & education, outreach, health & social services, and civic advocacy.

KCC's Vision is to provide practical tools and assistance for Korean immigrants to overcome their language and cultural barriers, and to preserve and promote Korean cultural heritage and social identity through self-empowerment and a spirit of participation and giving while building bridges to American Society.

The Evolution of the Korean Community Center

In 2000, a group of elderly Korean immigrants in Fort Lee, NJ formed Friends of Grace Seniors (FGS), to serve and empower its new and growing community of Korean Americans. These founding elders quickly became an anchor for all generations of Koreans in the area, ensuring access to health, social, cultural and educational services. In 2004, the FGS rented and renovated a 20,000 square foot facility in Englewood, NJ, where it offered more than 100 different cultural and educational programs as well as comprehensive and professional health and social services. Over the years, the FGS evolved and changed its name to the Korean Community Center (KCC) to better reflect its rapidly expanding member base and scope of services. Today, the KCC and its programs are open to the broader community and benefit 12,000 Korean and non-Korean residents in surrounding towns and communities annually. At the beginning of January 2015, the KCC moved to its newly built, three-story, 21,000 square foot facility in Tenafly, NJ. With this new facility, the KCC hopes to better serve the next generation of Korean Americans as well as establish itself as a community service hub for all Korean Americans in Northern New Jersey. The KCC is committed to provide three core services:

1) Culture and Education services, 2) Youth and Family Services, and 3) Health and Social Services.



Judges Commentaries



It was very meaningful for me to participate as a judge for KCC 11th Children's Art Contest, especially at a newly constructed place. I was grateful for this opportunity to enjoy children's imaginations portrayed as artworks. Considering KCC's purpose of this contest, the art contest has embraced young artists' creativity, potentiality, and diversity by supporting young Korean American artists. All the participants achieved a true success in exposing and expressing their arts in their unique and sincere ways, and I truly congratulate for approaching to this important opportunity and gaining a valuable experience. With a heartfelt respect, I hope children would continue to express themselves through art and impress each other.

Kyung Youl Yoon is currently working as an artist and a director of Riverside Gallery. Yoon finished his studies of painting and printmaking at the University of Bellas Artes in Spain and constantly continued his art career by actively having art exhibitions in New York, New Jersey, Shanghai, China, Korea, and Europe. As a director of Riverside Gallery, he unveils emerging artists, and signifies artistic creativity and uniqueness. Artist Yoon works with oil-based paint, acrylic paint, watercolor paint, plexi-glass, mirrors, mixed media, and printmaking to create artworks. He tries to express his internal self, emotions, imagination, thoughts, and mind through his paintings; which are metaphorically expressed as an existence in a vast world, diminishing echoes, marks, and textures become seeds and new forms of a meaningful river. His recent exhibitions include Shanghai Liu Haisu Art Museum, Artiosino Gallery in New York, Kiaf Art Fair in Seoul, Chelsea Art Walk in New York, MEAC Exchange exhibitions in Spain, and others.



It was a great honor to be a judge for the Children's art contest at KCC. This was an amazing opportunity to see the imaginative energy of so many young, creative minds in expressing "The Family." I am very proud of all the contestants for working very hard in celebrating their family and exploring beyond, to include animals and other creatures around the world within an emotional and touching story. Within their vibrant and lovely colors and well composed paintings, I saw their little minds expressing the happy moments of their family. Pablo Picasso once said, "Every child is an artist. The problem is how to remain an artist once he grows up." So I would like to encourage all of us children to open up our senses and express freely how we feel

through art, to keep exploring and never stop imagining.

The colors of drawing stand for the children's first communication and strong perspective sight to tell their imaginations. Therefore the geometrical figures with beautiful colors from the award winning were expressed their thought, dream and future appropriately.
